

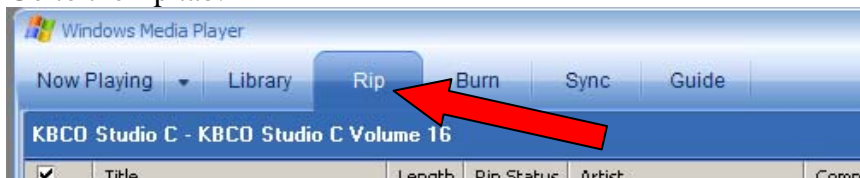


How To Rip/Burn a CD in Windows Media Player v10

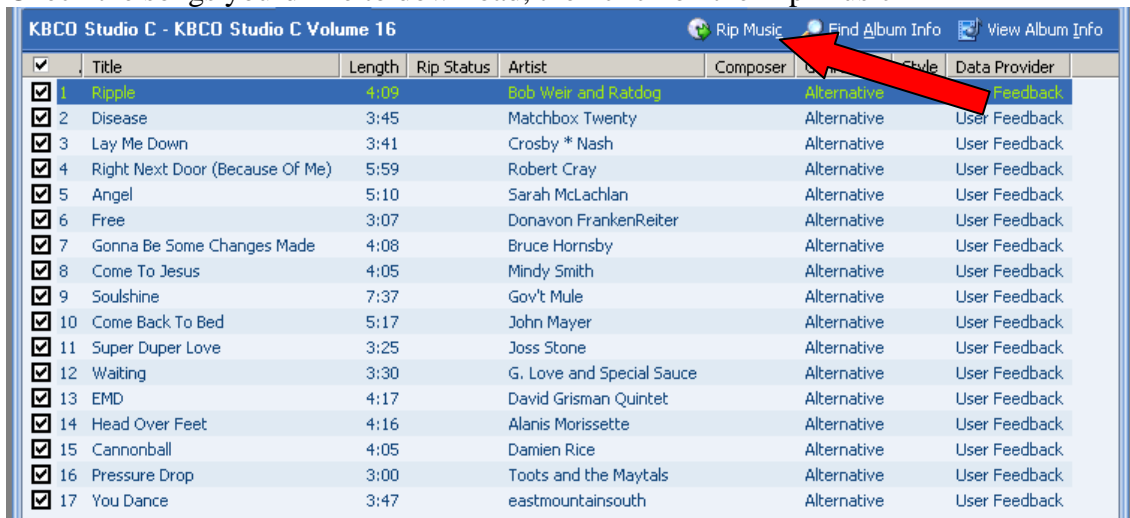
1. Windows Media Player v10 can be downloaded from <http://www.microsoft.com/downloads/>
2. Open Windows Media Player from Start>All Programs>Accessories>Entertainment>Windows Media Player

How to Rip:

1. Put in the CD you'd like to rip to your computer's Hard Drive. When the disc is inserted it will go out to the Internet and download the song titles and artists (if you are connected to the Internet)
2. Go to the rip tab:

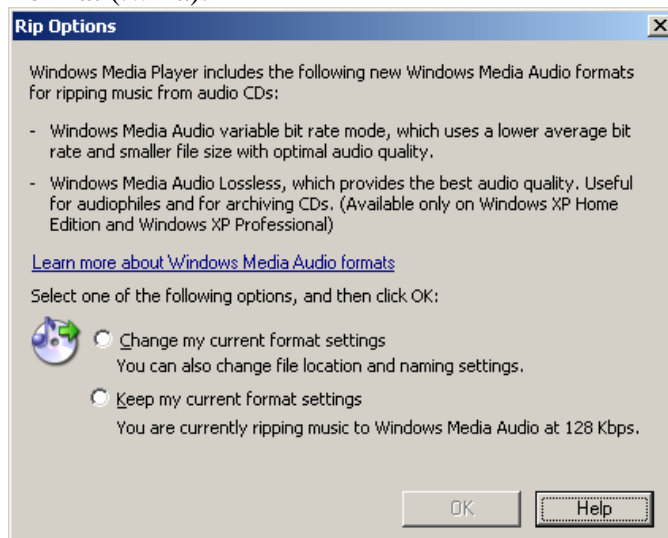


3. Check the songs you'd like to download, then click on the Rip Music Link



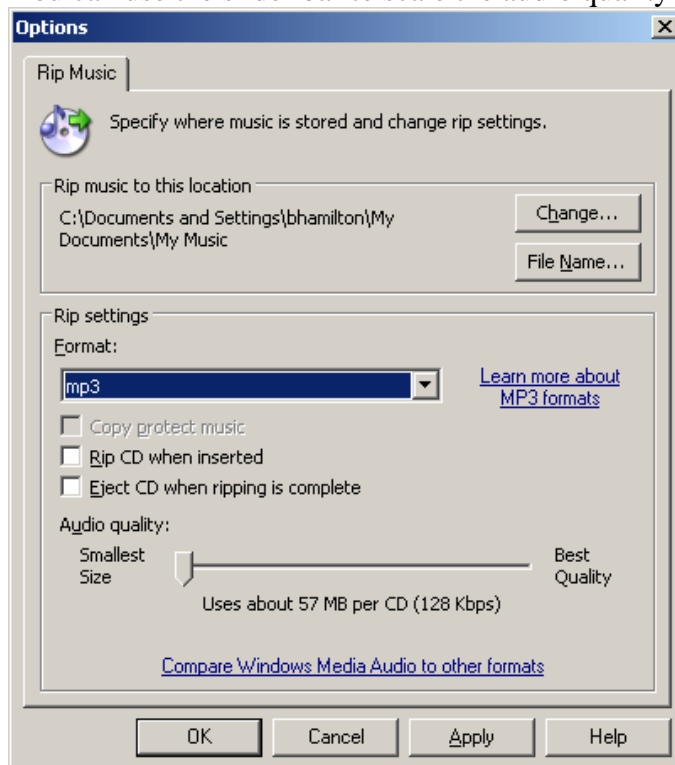

4. You will be presented with this Window, if you'd like to change the default save location from My Music, select the top option. If not, select the bottom option and your music will be saved in your My Music folder in Windows Media Audio Format (.wma).



5. If you choose the first option, you can edit where your music will be saved and what format it will be saved in. Options format are:
- Windows Media Audio
 - Windows Media Audio (Variable)
 - Windows Media Audio (Lossless)
 - Mp3

You can use the slider bar to scale the audio quality



How to Burn a CD of songs on your computer:

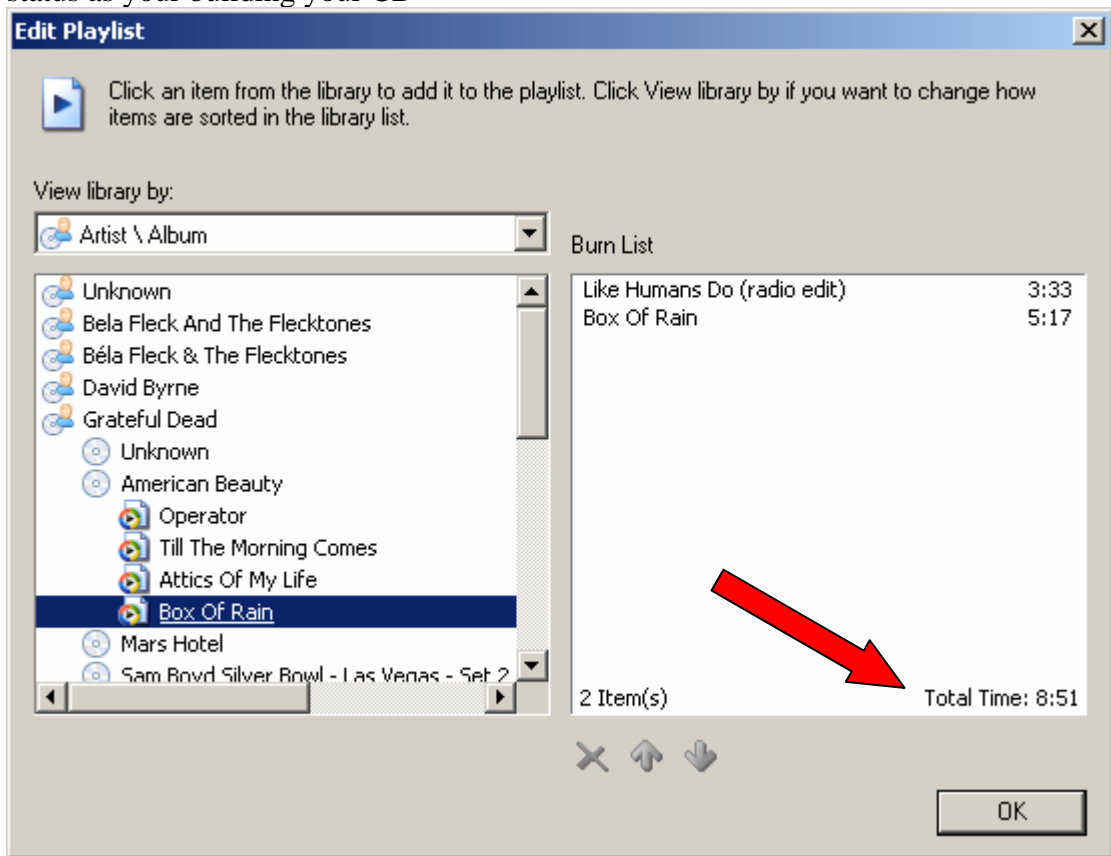
1. Insert a blank CD into your CD burner



2. Click on Edit Playlist



3. Select the songs you'd like on your CD from your Library and click OK. Keep in mind that most blank CDs allow for 80 minutes of music, monitor your time status as your building your CD



4. Once you've selected your songs, click Start Burn
